Our Website uses Analysis Cookies to analyse web user behaviour.

Cookies are small data files created on visiting a website and stored in the cookie logs of each computer or mobile telephone.

Each cookie contains a unique, anonymous code. Each website can send its own cookies to the user's browser if it is configured to accept them.

In all cases, it is the user who can decide whether to accept these cookies, via the configuration of his/her browser.
